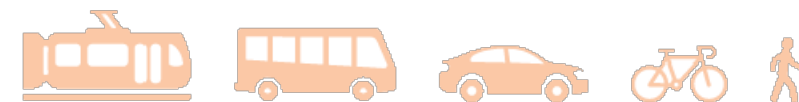
Local Partnership Program (LPP)

- Created with Senate Bill 1 (SB 1), 2017
- Reward for voter approved taxes and fees
- \$200 million annually
- Competitive and
- Formulaic



Competitive Guidelines

- Cycle 3
- Fiscal years 23-24 and 24-25
- \$144 million available statewide
- Maximum award \$25 million
- One-to-one match
- Construction only
- Applications due November 29th
- STA prioritization



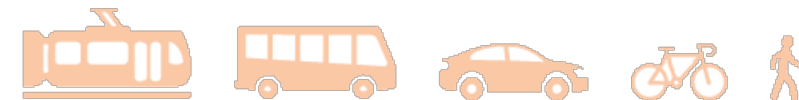
LPP Competitive Criteria

- 1) Accessibility*
- 2) Air Quality & Greenhouse Gases
- 3) Community Engagement*
- 4) Cost Effectiveness
- 5) Deliverability
- 6) Leveraging
- 7) Safety
- 8) System Preservation

9) Transportation, Land Use, and Housing Goals

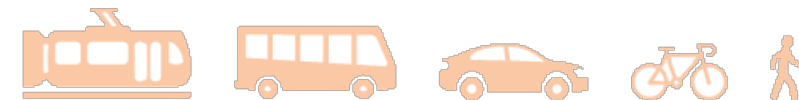
10) Vehicle-Miles Traveled

* Emphasis on disadvantaged or historically impacted and marginalized communities.



Process

- 1) Project Nomination Form
 - Project Information
 - Alignment with 10 Evaluation Criteria
 - Regional Benefit
- 2) Presentations
 - 10 minutes per project
- 3) Prioritization
 - Subsequent meeting
 - Informal poll
 - Formal prioritization

July 29th, 2022	STA call for nominations
September 2nd, 2022	Nominations due to STA
September 6th ,2022	Presentations due to STA
September 15th, 2022	Presentations to STA Board
October 13th, 2022	STA Board prioritization
November 29th, 2022	STA submits applications
June 28-29, 2023	CTC SB1 LPP (Competitive) Awards
