# Background

The SacMetro Freeway Service Patrol (FSP) Program is a joint effort between the Sacramento Transportation Authority (STA), the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) and the California Highway Patrol (CHP).

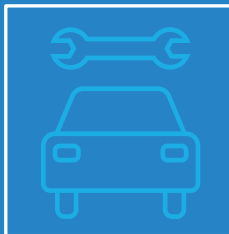
The FSP program reduces freeway congestion by quickly finding and removing minor incidents from freeways.

Minor incidents are responsible for more than half of all non-recurrent freeway congestion.

Special FSP coverage can include providing construction tow coverage as part of traffic management plans (TMP) for major construction projects.

- Sacramento I-80 Ramp Rehabilitation



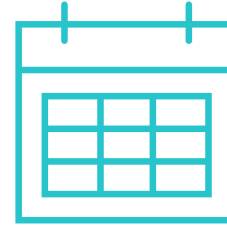
